Professor Dr Igor Calzada, MBA, FeRSA (@ICalzada) is accredited Full Professor/Research Professor in Social Sciences and Humanities by Unibasque (Agency for Quality of the Basque University System) and Ikerbasque Principal Investigator (PI)/Established Researcher (R3)/Associate Professor at the University of the Basque Country, Department of Public Policy and Economic History, Faculty of Economics & Business and a Principal Research Fellow/Reader at Cardiff University, School of Social Sciences. His main research interest draws on how digital transformation processes driven by AI disruptions are altering democratic conditions of data governance for the emergence of new digital citizenship regimes in cities and regions in reference to nation-states rescaling phenomena.
